Matthew 8:29-31

Jude 1:6

Luke 17:26-30

Genesis 19:24-29

The judgement and destruction of

was, is only a type or foreshadow
of the wrath that follows death.

God's wrath is not fully expressed in
physical death, but in eternal death.

Jude 1:7

just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding
cities, which likewise indulged in sexual immorality
and pursued unnatural desire, serve as an example
by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire.

Is your soul tormented by
the evil that is around you?

Never become calloused to the
culture of evil that surrounds us,
and certainly never approve of it.

Learn from Lot, it is far better to hurt
and be hated by an entire metroplex
of people than to be hated by God.

1 Peter 1:3-5

Submitting to the authority of Jesus
Christ is not just verbal but behavioral.

1 John 3:9-10

No one born of God makes a practice of sinning,
for God's seed abides in him; and he cannot keep
on sinning, because he has been born of God. By
this it is evident who are the children of God, and
who are the children of the devil: whoever does
not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is
the one who does not love his brother.
